

SBF 127 and 128 Information 2017-1

SBF 127:16 "Guidelines for fire protection on work vehicles and work machines" enters into effect 1 April 2017

Corrections and clarifications:

In section 4.9 safety class 11 has been added. In section 7.4.2.1 it has been clarified that TPED is also included. In 7.5.1, due to inquiries from producers of fire extinguishing systems, it has become accepted that the fire extinguishing system be integrated in the CAN-bus system of the vehicle. In 9.5 the type designation of the extinguisher and the have been corrected. In 9.6.1 it is stated that foam extinguishers can replace powder extinguishers under certain circumstances.

Safety class 11 applies for lorries which are delivered as from 1 april 2017 and which transport loose fire hazardous material such as saw dust, wood chips or round timber. Any exception from the requirements is a matter for the insurance company in question.

The following changes have been made in the E-norm edition as well as in the English printed edition of the guidelines. In the Swedish printed edition the information will be included in the next printing of the edition.

4.9 Fire inspections/Verification of system

Vehicles in safety classes 1, 2 and 11 shall also undergo verification of the fire suppression system. Verification shall be performed by personnel authorized for the fire suppression system.

7.4.2.1 Extinguishing system with powder - General

Agent tanks, cartridges, pipe systems and hoses which are exposed to internal pressure must comply with, and be handled in accordance with applicable official standards and instructions, the Pressure Equipment Directive (PED) and the Transportable Pressure Equipment Directive (TPED).

7.5.1 Fire suppression system's electrical system - General

The requirement "The electrical system of the fire suppression system, electrical cables and junction boxes, shall **to the least possible extent** be integrated with the vehicle's other electrical systems." has been cancelled.

9.5 Safety classes

Safety class 11 Permanently mounted fire suppression system class 2

- 2 frost-protected liquid portable fire extinguishers of at least class 13A 144 B C, 6 litres according to SS-EN 3.
- Shut down devices according to sections 4.2 and 7.3 for the following:
 - Electrical system
 - Fuel systems

9.6.1 Supplementary information on Safety classes - Portable fire extinguishers

Portable fire extinguishers do not need to be of class C in the event that there is no risk of gas fires. A portable fire extinguisher with liquid of class 43A 233B may, for instance, in this case replace a portable fire extinguisher with powder of class 43A 233B C.
